VoteByMail.io is a platform provided by Civex Incorporated (“Civex,” “we,” or “us”) that allows civic groups to help voters to register to vote by mail through landing pages they create. This Privacy Policy refers to these civic groups as “Organizers.” This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect when you visit VoteByMail.io (the “Site”), including if you register to vote, how we use the information we collect, how we disclose the information we collect, and your rights.

We may change this Privacy Policy from time to time. If we make changes, we will notify you by revising the date at the top of the policy and, in some cases, we may provide you with additional notice (such as by sending you an email notification). We encourage you to review the Privacy Policy whenever you access the Site to stay informed about our information practices and the ways you can help protect your privacy.

COLLECTION OF INFORMATION

Information You Provide to Us

We collect information you provide directly to us. For example, we collect information when you fill out a form to vote by mail, send us an email, sign up to receive emails reminding you to vote, communicate with us via third party social media sites, request information, or otherwise communicate with us. When you register to vote by mail, we and the Organizer of the landing page you visit collect the information necessary to allow you to sign up for vote by mail in your state. This may include your name, email address, voter registration address, postal address, phone number, mobile number, the last four digits of your Social Security Number, Driver's License Number, political affiliation, signature, and other contact or identifying information you choose to provide or that may be necessary in order to register you to vote by mail. We also collect information from Organizers as they log into our website, send us an email, sign up to receive emails, or otherwise communicate with us.

Information Collected Automatically When You Use the Site

When you access or use our Site we and the Organizer of the landing page you visit may automatically collect information about you, including log information and device information. The information we collect includes information about the device and network you use, such as your hardware model, operating system version, mobile network, IP address, user agent, unique device identifiers, browser you use as well as your activity on our Site, such as access times, pages viewed, links clicked, and the page you visited before navigating to our Site.

Cookies

We, our Organizers, and our service providers use tracking technologies, such as cookies, web browser local storage, and web beacons, to collect information when you visit our Site. Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive or in device memory that help us improve our Site and your experience, see which areas and features of our Site are popular, and count visits. Web beacons (also known as “pixel tags” or “clear GIFs”) are electronic images that may be used on our Site or emails and help deliver cookies, count visits, and understand usage. For more information about cookies, and how to disable them, please see the Your Choices section below.

Information We Collect From Other Sources

We may also obtain information from third parties or other sources and combine that with information we collect through our Site. For example, a third party or organization may inform us that your registration for Vote by Mail is not complete or that you have not yet received your vote by mail ballot, so that we can follow up with the election official on your behalf.

USE OF INFORMATION

We use information we collect to provide, maintain, and improve our Site and to serve or Organizers. We also use the information we collect to:

- Provide and deliver the information you request, and send you related information;
- Request feedback and to otherwise contact you about your use of the Site;
- Respond to your emails, comments, questions and requests;
- Send you newsletters and alerts and otherwise provide you with information you request or that we think will be of interest to you, such as sending you reminders to register to vote by mail or to vote;
- Monitor and analyze trends, usage and activities in connection with our Site;
- Link or combine with information we get from others to ensure you receive your election ballot and to provide you with better service; and
- Carry out any other purpose for which the information was collected.

Sharing of Information

We may share information about you as follows or as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy:

- With election officials to request your absentee or vote by mail ballot, on your behalf;
- With the Organizer on whose landing page you register to vote by mail;
- With vendors, consultants and other service providers or volunteers who need access to such information to carry out work on our behalf;
- With an organization seeking to challenge the refusal of an election official to provide you or others with a vote by mail ballot;
- In response to a request for information if we believe disclosure is in accordance with any applicable law, regulation or legal process, or as otherwise required by any applicable law, rule or regulation;
- If we believe your actions are inconsistent with the spirit or language of our user agreements or policies, or to protect the rights, property and safety of Civex, its employees, contractors, volunteers, or others; and
- With your consent or at your direction, including if we notify you that the information you provide will be shared in a particular manner and you provide such information.

We may also share aggregated or anonymized information that does not directly identify you. We do not sell the personal information we collect.

Organizers and Links to Other Websites

Any personal information you provide on an Organizer's landing page or on a page linked from our Site, such as to an Organizer's website or pages where you can use Vote.org to sign up to Vote by Mail, is provided directly to that organization or third party and is subject to that Organizer or third party's privacy policy. We encourage you to learn about their privacy and security practices and policies before registering to vote on their landing page or providing them with personal information.

Social Sharing Features

The Site may offer social sharing features and other integrated tools (such as the Facebook "Like" button), which let you share actions you take on our Site with other media, and vice versa. The use of such features enables the sharing of information with your friends or the public, depending on the settings you establish with the entity that provides the social sharing feature. For more information about the purpose and scope of data collection and processing in connection with social sharing features, please visit the privacy policies of the entities that provide these features.

Transfer of Information to the U.S.

Civex is based in the United States and the information we collect is governed by U.S. law. By accessing or using the Site or otherwise providing information to us, you consent to the processing and transfer of information in and to the U.S. and other countries.

Analytics Services Provided by Others

We may allow others, including Organizers, to provide analytics services and serve advertisements on our behalf or on behalf of Organizers across the web. These entities may use cookies, web beacons, device identifiers and other technologies to collect information about your use of the Site and other websites and applications, including your IP address, web browser, mobile network information, pages viewed, time spent on pages or in mobile apps, links clicked, and conversion information. This information may be used by us and others to, among other things, analyze and track data, determine the popularity of certain content, deliver advertising targeted to your interests on other websites, and better understand your online activity.
